Morning sessions run from 8.45am - 11.45am

Afternoon sessions run from 12.30pm - 3.30pm

Lunchtime sessions are available from 11.45am - 12.30pm

You may be eligible for **tax free childcare** through Gov.uk where you'll set up an online childcare account for your child. For every £8 you pay into this account, the government will pay an additional £2 to use to pay for your before and after school club care. To find out more click here.

Funded Hours Available

Each child is entitled to 15 hours per week of free universal provision during term time.

- £4.00 if you provide a packed lunch for your child

How to Apply

All children who are already 3 years old are eligible to apply. Dependent upon your child's birthday you may already be entitled to 15 hours per week of free universal provision.

All children who are 3 years old by 31st August will be entitled to the 15 universal hours per week from 1st September, children who turn 3 years old by 31st December, will be entitled to the 15 free hours per week from 1st January and all children who are 3 years old by 31st March 2021 will be eligible from 1st April.

Once we have received your enquiry and checked availability, you will receive a letter from school advising whether you have received a place. An application pack will then be sent to you which includes a set of admission forms and further information about our nursery and wraparound care.

Prior to accepting the offer you should be committed to your child regularly attending. Places may be withdrawn where attendance is unsatisfactory.

Once we have your acceptance form and parental agreement, we will send you a welcome pack with all the relevant information.

If you are not offered a place your child's name will be placed on the nursery waiting list. If a place becomes available this will be offered in accordance with the admission criteria
