Please note the following changes to the arrangements for the Sports Relief Mile:

On the day of the event, children can come to school in sports clothing (for the day- no uniform) and the wearing of trainers/pumps are recommended to complete the course. Any child who has an inhaler will be asked to carry them around the course whilst they complete it. Children and any accompanying adults will be asked to make a donation of a pound which will be collected and sent to the Sports Relief Fund.
