Scopay to ParentPay transfer

Parentpay will be effective from 1st April however Scopay will no longer be accessible from Tuesday 27th March. This means that there will be a few days when you will not be able to access either online system. During this time, we will be transferring all information across from Scopay. Once the system is updated we will send out activation letters by email so that you can start to use the new ParentPay system. You will then be able to make bookings for after school club, breakfast club and order school dinners which we hope will make things a lot easier for you.
