School Lunches



The current lunch menu and pre-ordered meals will end on Friday 18th May. The new menus will not be going out as the usual hard copy, they will be available for you to make your own online selections via the ParentPay system. If you have not yet activated your account, you will need to do this as soon as possible

so that you can access the lunch ordering system. Please be aware, as with the previous ordering system, that if you do not pre-order a lunch for your child (ren), it is not guaranteed that they will get the meal of their choice.

You also need to note, that if you pay for school meals, the ParentPay system will prompt you to pay for what you are booking, so please ensure that you can allocate the necessary payment for the amount of meals you are ordering.

There are still three weeks to go before you need to have new orders in place, therefore if anyone is having difficulty trying to access the online option, please call into the school office.

Toast

From Monday April 30th we have decided that we will trial only selling toast on a Friday playtime. Children are welcome to bring in a piece of fruit or a healthy snack for playtime if you would like them to. We have come to this decision for a number of reasons. Firstly over the summer months it seems a shame that some of our children spend quite a large proportion of their playtime queuing for and then eating their snack rather than being outside enjoying the warm weather. Also we are very much encouraged to be a healthy school and providing high calorie drinks and snacks does not support this ethos fully and finally the provision of these snacks runs at a loss for the school which means that currently our very tight resources are being strained to support the playtime snacks when we need to ensure we spend our resources wisely to best meet the educational needs of the children. We will provide toast on a Friday as usual as a treat at the end of the week.


<u>Year 2</u>
