All reception class children and nursery children that have joined us this week, will have received an online access letter and instructions to register with Scopay, our online bookings and payment system. If anyone has misplaced their letter, please contact the school office and we will send another one home. You must register with Scopay to be able to book wraparound care and school meals and to make payments to school.

School Meals

Apologies, there was a change to today's dessert choice, due to delivery shortages. We were meant to be offering ice cream, but had to make shortbread biscuits instead. Please continue, to make your bookings online, as this is a great help to the office and the school kitchen.

Wraparound Care

Please book breakfast and after school club in advance via Scopay. (You do not need to pre-book the Early Bird drop off at 8.30am).

Last minute bookings have a significant impact on staffing. You will no longer be permitted to book your child into either club if prepayment isn't made. If an emergency occurs please contact the office as soon as possible. We do understand this occasionally happens but we will monitor patterns of this. Late collection will result in additional charges.

Attendance/Absences

Please call the school office to advise of an absence before 9am. Please arrange medical appointments outside of school hours where possible, and let the office know before hand if you need to collect your child early for this.
