#### **Nursery Outdoor Area Development- Parent Views**

We are currently looking at developing the outdoor area for our new nursery to create an imaginative and innovative play area. We would like to develop the unused stepped area beside the nursery (this was previously the library). Our proposed design includes a three tier play area with a range of safe surfaces, an integral staging area and a sand pit and climbing/sliding equipment. The Big Lottery Fund are keen to hear parent's views which will support our bid. If the bid is successful it will fund a large proportion of the project.
