School Lunches

School menus have now been updated on ParentPay for the whole of the summer term. You will now be able to book lunches up until we finish for the summer break. Please can we politely request that you keep your lunch bookings up to date - Thank you to everyone who already does this, it is a great help.

Unfortunately, however, we find that we are continually having to send reminders and still make dozens of choices everyday, for the children who haven't had meals pre-ordered for them. This causes a delay in getting catering numbers to the kitchen, not to mention the time taken in the office each morning ensuring that the children will be happy with the food that we select for them. Ideally, the kitchen needs to know in advance, quantities of food that need to be ordered for the following week, we are unable to do this at present due to the shortage of advanced bookings.

We are very lucky at Middleforth to have the convenience of a pre-booking facility, most schools will only serve a quantity of each meal choice and very often children are given what's left. Sadly, if we don't see an improvement with this, we will have to limit the choices available for lunches added each day.
