School Lunches

School menus have now been updated on ParentPay for the whole of the summer term. There are still a number of children who haven't had meals pre-ordered for them. This causes a delay in getting catering numbers to the kitchen, not to mention the time taken in the office each morning choosing their meals.

We are very lucky at Middleforth to have the convenience of a pre-booking facility, most schools will only serve a quantity of each meal choice and very often children are given what's left. Sadly, if we don't see an improvement with this, we will have to limit the choices available for lunches added each day.
