Social Media

Can I please remind everyone that most social media sites are appropriate for children aged 13 and over as we continue to have a large number of issues related to inappropriate use of social media, chatting on xbox which are spilling into school and causing many problems for us. Please monitor your children's use of their technology. A very big thank you to the parents who have responded so well to us and have supported us when problems have arisen, this is such a great help to us. Please also monitor the playing of games which are not age appropriate such as Fortnite which is not appropriate for young children and again causes us so many problems in school.

End of Year School Trips

All school trips have now been finalised for your child's class and have been added to the list of dates at the end of the newsletter. There is a school spider survey for each class trip that needs to be completed please. If you haven't used the survey system for a little while, you will probably need to refresh it in order for a new survey to be displayed.

You can pay for your trip online via Scopay, where there is an option for you tick the consent box and type in any additional information that we need to be aware of. You can also pay by cash or cheque at the school office if you have problems accessing Scopay.

Online Systems and Advance Bookings

Whilst we are aware that we have several online systems in place at present and it can be very confusing, may we please ask for your continued support in keeping bookings and payments up to date. You are able to book in advance for both school meals and before/after school clubs. This is really important and will help to avoid disappointment and upset at lunchtimes if children don't have the choice of a meal that they like or any confusion at the end of the day with last minute after school club bookings.
