It's quick and easy to do and you will receive email confirmation of your application. You must apply even if you already have siblings in school. The closing date for primary applications for September 2020 is 23:59 on **15 January 2020**.

#### Special Lunches – Harvest, Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October

There has been an amendment to our lunchtime menu for next Thursday 3rd October. We are now having a special Harvest lunch!



This special menu replaces the one that we had scheduled. If you had already pre-booked a lunch, your original meal choice will have been overridden and you will need to log on to ParentPay to make a new selection.

Choices include:- 'Pulled Pork Burger with Oven Baked Chips' and 'Farmers Bean Bake with Crusty Bread' with a choice from two special desserts 'Toffee Apple Pancakes' or 'Chocolate Cookie'. We will still have a Jacket Potato option available on the day as well.

#### Y3 Trip - Blackpool Zoo, Friday 4th October

Payments of £17.50 should now have been made either online via Scopay or at the school office. If you would like your child to have a packed lunch prepared by the school kitchen you must let the office know by Monday morning or we will assume that they are bringing one from home. Children are to wear their full school uniform, we will leave after registration and arrive back in time for the end of the normal school day.

#### **Food Tech Lessons**

Year 5 and 6 are taking part in food tech lessons this half term. For these lessons we ask parents for a small contribution of £1.50 towards the cost of ingredients. This amount is added to the children's Scopay account and can be paid online or by cash to the school office.

#### **Booking and Payment Reminders**

A polite reminder from the office to continue to keep your lunch and before/after school booking and payments up to date. We are still experiencing a number of last minute after school club bookings which causes a build of unpaid accounts. We do understand that some situations are unavoidable, but planning and booking in advance helps to keep both parents and school on track. The Scopay site is very easy to use, (try to avoid using the mobile app), you first have to credit your account, then order the sessions that you require. You are able to make bookings up until midnight of the day before you need them for lunches and before/after school.

A huge thank you to everyone for keeping lunches up to date, this has made a significant difference to the kitchen in helping with their orders. We are hoping that the Autumn menu will be ready to publish during October, we will advise parents once it is available on ParentPay.
