Booking and Payment Reminders - Breakfast and After School Club

A polite reminder from the office to continue to keep your lunch and before/after school booking and payments up to date particularly after a weekend or school holiday. We are still experiencing a number of last minute after school club bookings which causes a build of unpaid accounts. The Scopay site is very easy to use, (try to avoid using the mobile app), you first have to credit your account, then order the sessions that you require. You are able to make bookings up until midnight of the day before you need them for lunches and before/after school.
