Booking and Payment Reminders – Breakfast and After School Club

A polite reminder from the office to continue to keep your lunch and before/after school booking and payments up to date particularly after a weekend or school holiday. The Scopay site is very easy to use, (try to avoid using the mobile app), you first have to credit your account, then order the sessions that you require.
