














Primary School Applications

Booking and Payment Reminders - Breakfast and After School Club

A polite reminder from the office to continue to keep your lunch and before/after school booking and payments up to date, particularly after a weekend or school holiday. We are still experiencing a number of last minute after school club bookings which causes a build-up of unpaid accounts. We do understand that some situations are unavoidable, but planning and booking in advance helps to keep both parents and school on track. The Scopay site is very easy to use, (try to avoid using the mobile app). You first have to credit your account, then order the sessions that you require. You are able to make bookings up until midnight of the day before you need them for lunches and before/after school.

School meals are available for booking up until March 2020, please ensure that you have menu choices in place ready for when we return at the Christmas holidays.

Attendance/Absences

Please can we remind you of the importance in contacting school if your child is going to be absent on a school day. If your child is going to be absent due to illness, you must contact the office before 9.00am. If you are reporting outside of school hours or the phoneline is busy, you can email, text or leave a message on the answerphone.

We have had an increase in absences due to illness this half term and it can take a great deal of time in the morning to firstly check classrooms to see if the child arrived late and just missed registration, or in contacting parents to find out why they haven't arrived. If we have not heard from or been able to make contact with a -parent/carer at the time of registration, we are obliged by LCC to report that child as missing.

If your child is going to be absent from school for a medical appointment, please advise the office of the date and time. Ideally, making appointments outside of school hours would be advisable, however, where this is unavoidable we need advance notification.

If you are requesting to take your child out of school for any other reason, such as a holiday or celebration etc, you must complete an LCC leave of absence form which are available from the school office to request permission for the absence.
