Coronavirus arrangements

Thank you all so much for helping us with the new arrangements for coming in and out of school. We are so lucky to have parents who are supportive and who are helping us to keep everyone safe. From now on all our staff will wear masks or visors when they come out, not just those close to the gate, in the event they need to speak directly to a parent or visitor.

We are currently reviewing our lunchtime arrangements to move to having more children able to use the dining hall in a safe way. This does mean shifts in the hall with a clear space for cleaning in between.

Children will still all have the same amount of lunch hour but there are slight changes to the timings of their breaks to facilitate this.

Your support is really helping the school keep bubbles open and we pray that this continues to be the case for us. We are keeping up to date with guidance as it comes out and ensuring we make any changes in school to reflect updates.

Behaviour policy

We have updated our behaviour policy for school and there are some changes which reflect that we now have Ms Collins in school who can support behaviour. The policy has been shared with children in school and is now in place. The policy is on the school website under the policy section.

<u>School Meal Bookings – ParentPay</u>

Hot meals will be available from Monday 28th September. Menus have been now been published online and you can make your bookings via ParentPay. **Please can we remind you of the importance of booking meals in advance**. The kitchen need to have the number to place orders, which is especially important during these times when supplies can still be limited. It also helps from administrative point of view as it does generate a lot of extra work and eats into class learning time when we have to check what the children, who haven't pre-ordered, what they would like for their lunch.

Wraparound Care

Thank you all for adhering to the rules of booking a week in advance, this has been incredibly helpful and made such a difference in planning our staffing numbers. Please can you continue do this as we make our plans every Friday afternoon for the week following. Breakfast and After School clubs are booked online via ScoPay. It is best to avoid using the app and going directly to the webpage.

Foodbank help

We would like to restart our foodbank support to help the local foodbank and also anyone we come across through school who may need support during this very difficult time. We will have a box by the infant gate and on the key stage 2 playground at the end of each day. If you feel you are able to contribute anything please place your item into the box and once it has been in school for 72 hours we will distribute to the foodbanks or where appropriate. If you feel you would appreciate any support yourself in this way please can you contact Ms Collins in school and she will discuss any support she can offer.

Attendance/Absences

Please can we remind you of the importance in contacting school if your child is going to be absent on a school day. If your child is going to be absent due to illness, you must contact the office before 9.00am. If you are reporting outside of school hours or the phoneline is busy, you can email, text or leave a message on the answerphone. If we have not heard from or been able to make contact with a parent/carer at the time of registration, we are obliged by LCC to report that child as missing.

If your child is going to be absent from school for a medical appointment, please advise the office of the date and time. Ideally, making appointments outside of school hours would be advisable, however, where this is unavoidable we need advance notification.

If you are taking your child out of school for any other reason, such as a holiday or celebration etc, you must complete a LCC leave of absence form which are available from the school office.
