<u>Christmas Dinner Wednesday 16th December.</u> Please book via ParentPay – if you had previously made a booking for this day, you will need to rebook for Turkey or Quorn Christmas Dinner. <u>There are no other menu choices available on this day</u>, however, children can still bring their own packed lunch and sit with their friends for lunch.

Please remember to continue keeping your bookings up to date via ParentPay, as far as you possibly can as it really is a great help. We use pre-booked meals to determine the kitchen food order numbers for the following week. **Children who don't have a pre-booked meal, may not receive the meal of their choice.**

Wraparound Care

Thank you all for adhering to the rules of booking a week in advance, this has been incredibly helpful and made such a difference in planning our staffing numbers. Please can you continue do this as we make our plans every Friday afternoon for the week following. We are finding that on occasion this is not being done and causing problems at both ends of the day. Breakfast and After School clubs are booked online via ScoPay.

Attendance/Absences

Please can we remind you of the importance in contacting school if your child is going to be absent on a school day. If your child is going to be absent due to illness, you must contact the office before 9.00am. If you are reporting outside of school hours or the phoneline is busy, you can email, text or leave a message on the answerphone. If we have not heard from or been able to make contact with a parent/carer at the time of registration, we are obliged by LCC to report that child as missing.

If your child is going to be absent from school for a medical appointment, please advise the office of the date and time. Ideally, making appointments outside of school hours would be advisable, however, where this is unavoidable we need advance notification. If you are taking your child out of school for any other reason, such as a holiday or celebration etc, you must complete a LCC leave of absence form which are available from the school office.
