School Meals – Moving to Tucasi/ScoPay from ParentPay

We have set the wheels in motion to move our school meal ordering program from ParentPay to Tucasi. This will mean that all of our booking/ordering and payment systems are in one place to save logging on to two different systems. You will still be able to make your meal bookings online, details of how to do this will follow at a later date. The new system won't be implemented for parents until around Easter time, so we have plenty of time to make sure that the transition is as easy as possible for everyone. In the meantime, **please could log on to your ParentPay account, before the half term break (Friday 12th February), and check that all outstanding balances are paid and any refunds are requested - this will ensure that everything is clear before we close ParentPay down.**
