Payment Reminders

Sports Day – Wednesday 30th June

Weather permitting, we have planned our school sports day for Wednesday 30th June. It will be a whole day event and all children will be taking part. We ask that children come into school wearing their PE Shorts, school pumps or own trainers and a T-shirt that represents the colour of their house team. In the case of a warm sunny day, please ensure that your child(ren) come to school with sun cream applied and bring a sun hat/cap with. Children with long hair should have tied up and it is advisable that no earrings are worn. As always, please ensure that everyone brings their water bottle with them.

Bog Eyed Jog - Friday 2nd July

One of our most popular school events 'The Bog Eyed Jog', is back this year, planned to take place on Friday 2nd July, as part of our Healthy Bodies and Minds focus.

The children have been given a sponsor form asking their family and friends to sponsor them to jog around the school field as many times as they can wearing their pyjamas, dressing gowns, 'onesies' etc. You can sponsor for each lap or for a fixed amount, regardless of how many laps are completed.

Due COVID restrictions, the children will take part in the event in their school bubble at specific times during the day. At the end of the school day children will be given a letter to take home telling their parents how many circuits they have completed in order for them to collect their sponsor money.

All monies raised will be used to fund the visit of the Life Bus during the school's Healthy Bodies and Minds focus and also, will go towards upgrading the Outdoor Area in KS1.

In previous years, we have found that the Life Bus makes a very significant contribution to development of the children's life-skills and through it we obtain our school subscription to the SCARF PSHE/ RSE health education programme. It also educates children about many other important areas such as peer pressure, the effects and risks of drugs, including alcohol and tobacco.

Booking and Payment Reminders

A polite reminder from the office to continue to keep your lunch and before/after school booking and payments up to date. We are still experiencing a number of last-minute after school club bookings which causes a build of unpaid accounts. We do understand that some situations are unavoidable, but planning and booking in advance helps to keep both parents and school on track. The Scopay app is very easy to use, you first have to credit your account, then order the sessions that you require. You are able to make bookings up until midnight of the day before you need them for lunches and before/after school.

A huge thank you to everyone who is keeping their lunch bookings up to date, this has made a significant difference to the kitchen in helping with their orders.

A reminder that if your child is displaying any of the symptoms of Covid they must isolate and have a PCR test rather than an LFT.
