Did you know that if you are eligible for Tax-Free Childcare, for every £8 you pay into your account, the government will pay in £2 to use to pay for your breakfast/after school club bookings? You will

need to set up an online childcare account for your child and you can get Tax-Free Childcare at the same time as 30 hours free childcare (nursery) if you're eligible for both. To find out more:

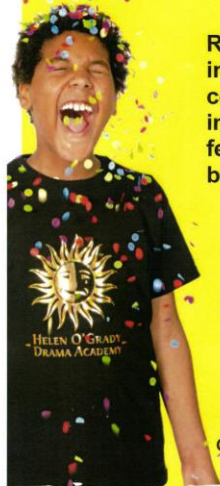
