Covid-19 Advice

Following the announcements this week, please see below the current government advice:

There is no longer a legal requirement for people with coronavirus (COVID-19) infection to self-isolate, however if you have any of the main symptoms of COVID-19 or a positive test result, the public health advice is to stay at home and avoid contact with other people.

This also applies to children and young people.

Close contacts who are fully vaccinated will no longer have to test daily for 7 days, while unvaccinated close contacts will not be required to self-isolate.

Where a child who is absent has a confirmed case of Covid, they will now be recorded as ill (rather than isolating) on their attendance records.
